I. Global Collaborative Scholarship Program(Undergraduates)

Qualifications

- 1) Applicant and both of the parents must have citizenship of a nation in the following regions:

**Southeast/Central Asia, Middle East, Eastern Europe,
Africa, South/Central America**

- 2) Applicant should be under 25 years of age at the time of submission
- 3) Applicant should be healthy enough to complete their study in Korea
- 4) Applicant must have completed general school education outside Korea

III. Admission for International Students

I. Global Collaborative Scholarship Program(Undergraduates)

- 5) Applicant must have a GPA of 80% or higher or be within the top 10% of the school's evaluation percentage
- 6) Applicant must not have enrolled in any other undergraduate courses in Korea previously
- 7) Applicant must have a Korean Proficiency Test score or an English Proficiency Test score.
(S-TOPIK(Standard Test of Proficiency in Korean) level 4
OR TOEFL iBT 80(CBT 210 / PBT 550) / TEPS 550)
